 You will have completed post 16 studies whether this be A-Levels, Btecs etc or a Level 3 Apprenticeship

You must not already have qualification in a similar subject at the same level, or higher level than this apprenticeship.

What you'll receive

On top of gaining your Level 4 Qualification, you will also be entitled to 20 days holiday per annum. You will also follow the CompTIA Pathway which will give you industry recognised qualifications in addition to your apprenticeship qualification.

Study & Future prospects:

If successful, you will study your Level 4 IT Network Engineer apprenticeship qualification through Firebrand.

The apprenticeship will take 15-18 months.
